

## COUNTRY HOMES PET POLICY

- Dogs and cats four (4) months and older must be registered in Polk County. Registration requires a current rabies vaccination.
- Registration fees vary based on the duration of the rabies vaccine (1-year or 3-year) and if your dog is spayed or neutered:
  - 1-Year License: \(\\$10\) (spayed/neutered) or \(\\$25\) (intact)
  - 3-Year License: \(\\$15\) (spayed/neutered) or \(\\$60\) (intact)
- You can register your dog in person through participating local veterinarians or online using the [Polk County Sheriff's Office Pet License Registration](#) portal.
- Pets must abide by the Florida Leash Law. Dogs must either be contained on your property or be under physical control of a capable handler at all times while in common areas.
- Handlers must immediately clean up all pet waste and dispose of it properly.
- Pets must not cause or create an unreasonable disturbance or nuisance.
- Pet owners assume full financial and legal responsibility for any personal injury or property damage caused by their pets.
